Careering through London in 24 hours of flashbacks, muses and communism, this farcical comedy will leave you at the edge of your seat.

Red Handed is Wilbert W Lawrence's comic indictment of 'Normality'. As he said to the press at the premiere of **Red Handed** at the Royal Court Theatre 'Normality is a state of being which is responsible for all that is wrong with society and the world'.

Lawrence's gripping self-portrait is based on his own early experiences on the wrong side of London's police, and the beginnings of a lifelong obsession with muses.

Wilbert W Lawrence was born in Aberdeen in 1988. Originally an actor and poet, he went on to win a *Tony award* for theatre writing. *Pelted in the Street by my Own Family*, was turned into the award winning film *Just Go*, in 2016. *Red Handed* has won three festival comedy awards, in Edinburgh, Brighton, and Dublin. His law suits with press and peers led him to try to unsuccessfully eradicate all mention of himself and his work from social media sites.

Performed by the cast of the 2nd year Drama Ensemble at Kinsale College this rare production of Wilbert's play, is bound to provoke belly giggles and possibly incite revolution.
